Girl safety is the first priority. Account immediately for all girls for whom you are responsible. 2. Contact 911 and GSCSM's Management Team. 3. If necessary, evacuate on foot or by car to Plymouth South High School, Long Pond Road. 4. Contact the adult back home who is the emergency contact for troop. Be certain that she knows how to contact you and that she is available to receive calls.

- **BATHROOM:** The heated bathroom is located between the front room and the dining hall. An accessible bathroom is located off the ramp alongside the dininghall. Toilet paper and paper towels are provided, stored on the storage shelf in the bathroom. Cleaning the toilet and sink and sweeping and mopping the floor before you leave are troop kapers.
- **BEDS AND MATTRESSES:** There are 20 mattresses for use on the floor, stored to the right of the front door. Do not remove the mattresses from the lodge.
- **FIREPLACE:** There is an indoor fireplace. Bring your own tinder, kindling and fuel size wood so the site is not denuded by constant use. Let fires in the fireplace go out by themselves – do not douse, as pouring water on hot bricks may cause them to crack. Treat the fully-cooled ashes as rubbish. Bag them in a heavy trash bag and put them in the dumpster. Feel free to leave any unused wood in the wood storage boxes for use by other troops.
- **HEAT:** The lodge is heated by a two wall gas-fired heaters. The thermostats are near the heaters. Set the heaters at no higher than 68 degrees during your stay, and turn them back to 55 degrees when you leave. There is a carbon monoxide monitor mounted in the lodge, as recommended with gas-fired burners.
- **KITCHEN:** The pantry is equipped with water, refrigerator and freezer. Bring your own cooking and eating gear. Do not leave any foodstuffs behind. Check the refrigerator, freezer and shelves before you leave. Cleaning the kitchen before leaving is a troop kaper. The dininghall kitchen is off-limits due to Board of Health regulations.
- **TELEPHONE:** The lodge telephone is for emergency use only. If you must make a toll call, please reverse the charges or make third-party calls. If non-emergency toll calls dated during your stay appear on the telephone bill, your troop is responsible for paying them.
- **TRASH:** Large trash bags are provided and are located in the kitchenette. Bag up the trash and put it in the dumpster near the lodge. Make sure the dumpster lid is closed so animals cannot get at the trash.
- **VEHICLES:** Once gear and supplies have been unloaded at the lodge, park all vehicles in the parking area at the top of the hill (except when snow prevents this). If a girl or adult has a special need that requires immediate access to a vehicle, one may be parked off the road on the Gallows Pond side of the lodge.
- **WATERFRONT:** No girl is allowed at the waterfront without an adult. No one is allowed in the water, in watercraft or on the docks unless GSCSM procedures and Safety Wise have been followed. A council-approved lifeguard is required. No fishing is allowed from the docks.
- **If you notice a problem requiring council attention** on the site during your stay (leaking faucet, problem with appliances, etc.), please notify the office on the first workday thereafter. We can then correct the problem before the next troop arrives at the site.
